Student Uniform Waiver Extension

YES Prep will waive the uniform policy for students for the entire 20-21 School Year. Students will follow the "free dress" policy as outlined in the <u>Individual Campus Supplement for their school</u>. Students have the option to wear a YES Prep-issued uniform.

The <u>Student Assistance Form</u> (SAF) is the best way to contact a Student Support Counselor.
